Reflection on the twentieth anniversary of September 11, 2001

Two steel girders from the World Trade Center, set in concrete blocks, adorn one hallway of the Knights of Columbus Museum in New Haven, Conn. Distorted from the intense heat and retrieved from the landfill in New York, the brown girders look like a piece of modernist sculpture, the metal waving as if caught in an upward gust of wind.

Nearby, a golden plaque lists the names of the 45 Knights killed in the attacks: 11 firefighters, six policemen, and 28 civilians, including one member who was a passenger on American Airlines Flight 11, the first plane that hit the Twin Towers. To be sure, September 11, 2001, was not a K of C tragedy or even a New York tragedy — it was an American tragedy, one that brought out some of the best that U.S. citizens had to offer. Knights were among those who did their part, actively embodying the Order's principles of charity and patriotism. We remember that day, twenty years ago, that changed our world. Just as the Knights have been doing since Blessed Michael J. McGivney founded us in 1882, we were there in prayer, support, and service. Charity is our number one focus; our order may change, the rituals, regalia we wear, the way we conduct business...our precept remains firmly in place. As we remember all of the heroes who lost their lives on 911 and those who suffered (and continue to suffer), we pray that we never experience such a day again. As Knights, we are vigilant, standing at our post, ready to respond when the call to serve is heard.
